



Keney Park Golf Course 2025 Golf Outings General Policies

- Outings will be played Monday through Thursday at 10:30AM (minimum 80 players for a shotgun), Fridays at 11:30AM, Saturdays, Sundays & Holidays at 1:00 p.m. (minimum 100 players). (Start times subject to change based on availability, time of year)
- Keney Park Golf Course offers tee times for smaller outing groups.
- Two weeks prior to the scheduled outing we require an estimated number of players, Seven days prior a guaranteed (billable) number of players along with final food & beverage selections.
- The invoice, less the deposit, is due immediately upon completion of the event.
- Proper etiquette and adherence to Keney Park Course rules regarding dress code, disposal of trash on the course and divot and ball mark repair are always expected.
- All Food and Beverage arrangements must be made through The Tavern at Keney Park Restaurant (Jasmine Castango).

- Food and Beverage arrangements with The Tavern at Keney Park Restaurant (Jasmine Castango).
- Player Gifts including towels, hats, golf balls or apparel.

Golf Carts

Keney Park Golf Course has a fleet of golf carts that can accommodate 112 players. If your outing exceeds 112 players, additional golf carts will need to be rented. Rental golf carts must be rented in blocks of 10 and the outing is responsible for the total cost. Arrangements must be made at least four (4) weeks prior to the outing date.

Rules & Regulations

1. All outings must try to finish play within 4 hours 30 minutes for 18 holes. Pace of Play Policy will be enforced.
2. In case of inclement weather, a decision will be made within two hours of the scheduled start time of your outing. If the course is closed due to lightning, play will be suspended, and staff will determine if play can resume that day. If the golf course is open, you are expected to play. Food & Beverage package will be served as scheduled.
3. Signage for outings will be placed on the golf course by Keney Park staff if it is delivered to the golf course no later than the day prior to the outing. In all other cases, signage must be placed on the golf course by representatives from the outing.
4. The outing is responsible for pick up and removal of all signage and other items on the golf course. Keney Park Golf Course will not assume any responsibility for lost or damaged items left on the golf course.
5. The outing is financially responsible for all damages to the golf course and golf carts from neglect, incorrect usage, recklessness and disregard.
6. Metal spikes are not allowed, and appropriate golf attire must be worn (no cutoffs, no sleeveless shirts).
7. In accordance with CT State Liquor Laws, alcoholic beverages are NOT ALLOWED on the golf course unless purchased through the food and beverage concession at Keney Park Golf Course. No food or beverage of any kind will be permitted to be brought into the facility by the patron or any of the patron's guests or invitees without prior approval from management. If food or beverage is brought into The Tavern, it must come from a certified/licensed distributor for public consumption. The Tavern is not responsible for food or beverage brought from the outside. The Tavern reserves the right to impose a room rental or labor charge fee for any outside food, beverage or vendors brought on property.
8. Keney Park Golf Course assumes no responsibility for injury on the golf course.
9. All participants are expected to leave the course in the condition in which it was found. Please fix ball marks, replace divots and rake bunkers.
10. There are no extra holes or replays. An outing round is for 18 holes with a golf cart. Any participant wishing to play more golf can purchase a greens fee from the golf shop.
11. All golfers are expected to follow general golf course etiquette guidelines. Disciplinary action may occur because of dangerous and irresponsible actions.
12. All outings are required to pay for the balance of their event on the day of the event. No exceptions.
